Transportation Requirement And Bus Rate Increase

Congregational Home knows the importance of getting our residents and tenants to their medical appointments and we are happy to offer vehicles and drivers to assist with this. For the safety of all involved, any resident whose Health Care Power of Attorney has been activated will require a family member or designee to ride along and attend their appointment with them. This will be reviewed when the appointment and transportation is being arranged. Outside caregiver agencies can be used if a loved one is not available and this should be arranged in advance by the Health Care Agent or family designee. Congregational Home drivers cannot safely leave a resident unattended if they have some deficits that could potentially cause a concern for their safety. We appreciate everyone's cooperation with this. Please reach out to your Social Worker if you have any questions or concerns.

Round trip cost of the Congregational Bus will be \$40, effective January 1.
