Old man winter is on his way to bringing us cold, snow and ice as he does each winter. We want everyone to remain safe during these cold, blustery and sometimes slippery days of winter. Having an emergency supply kit in your home and vehicle could save your life or a neighbor's life during a winter storm. Always make sure you have a flashlight and batteries in your apartment and vehicle in case of a power outage due to severe winter weather. Keep your cell phone charged during winter storms as well, in case of prolonged outages.

When out walking always watch for ice spots on sidewalks and parking lots. Be sure to wear appropriate footwear for the conditions. If you notice icy or slick areas around the property that need salt, please call the front desk and report these areas so we can get additional salt where it's needed to prevent any falls.

Before you travel, check with [511 Wisconsin](#) for the latest traffic and road conditions. This information, along with live traffic cameras and traffic alerts, can be accessed on the 511 Wisconsin system, which includes a free mobile app, [@511WI on X \(formerly Twitter\)](#), or the mobile-friendly site www.511wi.gov. You can also visit ReadyWisconsin.wi.gov, where you can find winter weather maps, along with tips on putting together emergency kits and winter driving.

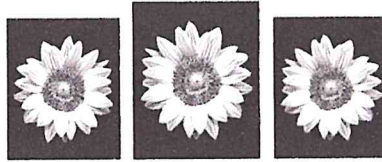
Employee Spotlight

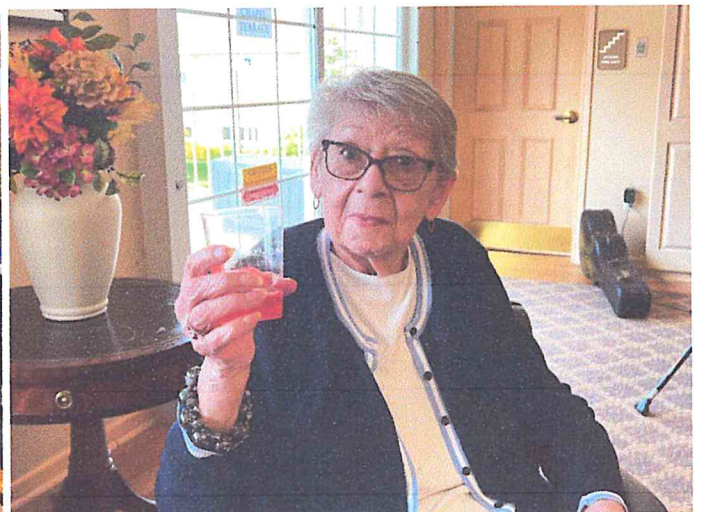
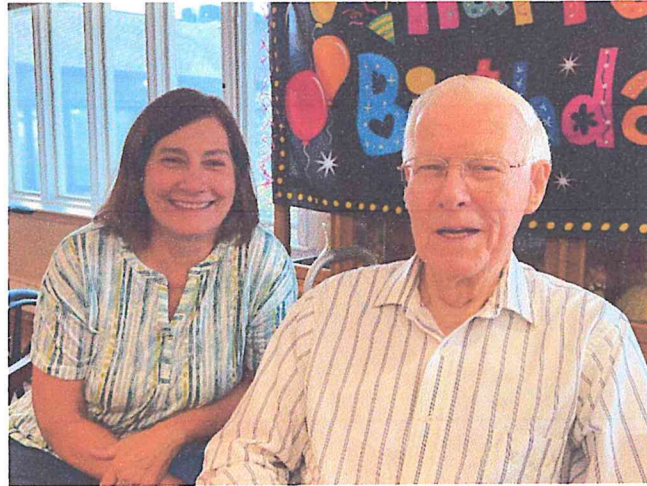
