- Physician and/or Nurse Practitioner Onsite Daily: One to two of these medical providers is
 onsite here 5 days a week thanks to our Partnership with FROEDTERT HEALTH and the "Mobile
 Care Team" they have placed at Congregational Home. This level of care is rarely seen in most
 other facilities and is key in helping to keep our residents stable and out of the hospital.
- 24-Hour Onsite RN Nurse Coverage: We have multiple RN's on all 3 shifts
- We have one of the Highest Nursing Staff Levels in the state
- No Temp Agency Staff: We use only our own staff to ensure quality & continuity of care
- Our <u>Dedicated Nursing Assistants</u> focus only on the care of residents, they are not pulled away to perform duties in the housekeeping, laundry or kitchen departments
- 24-Hour Help Call System with TALK CAPABILITY: Just like the hospitals have!
- <u>Full Continuum of Care</u>: We are one of a small percentage of organizations in the region that offers a Full Continuum of Care for seniors and it's *All Under One Roof!*
